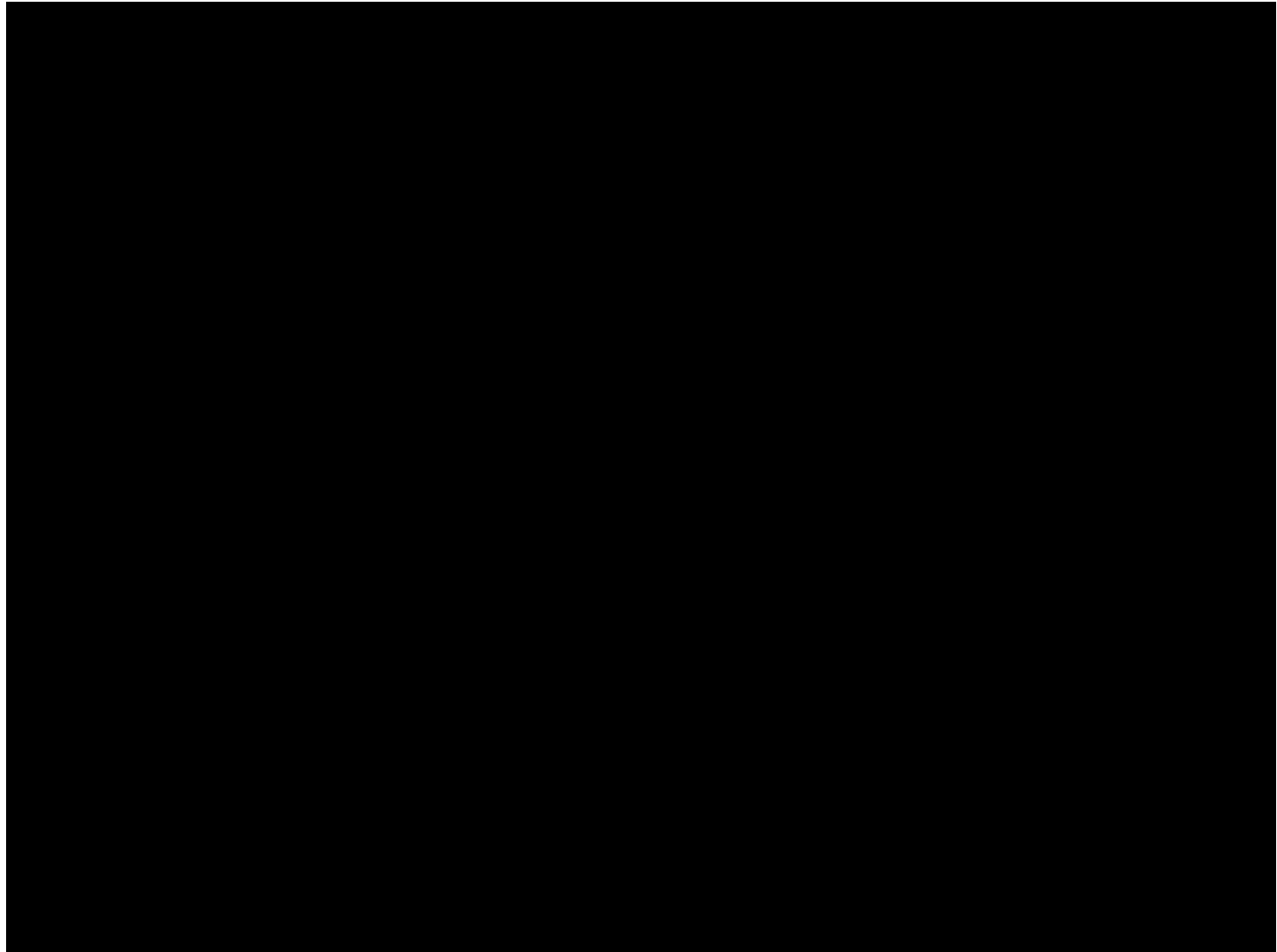

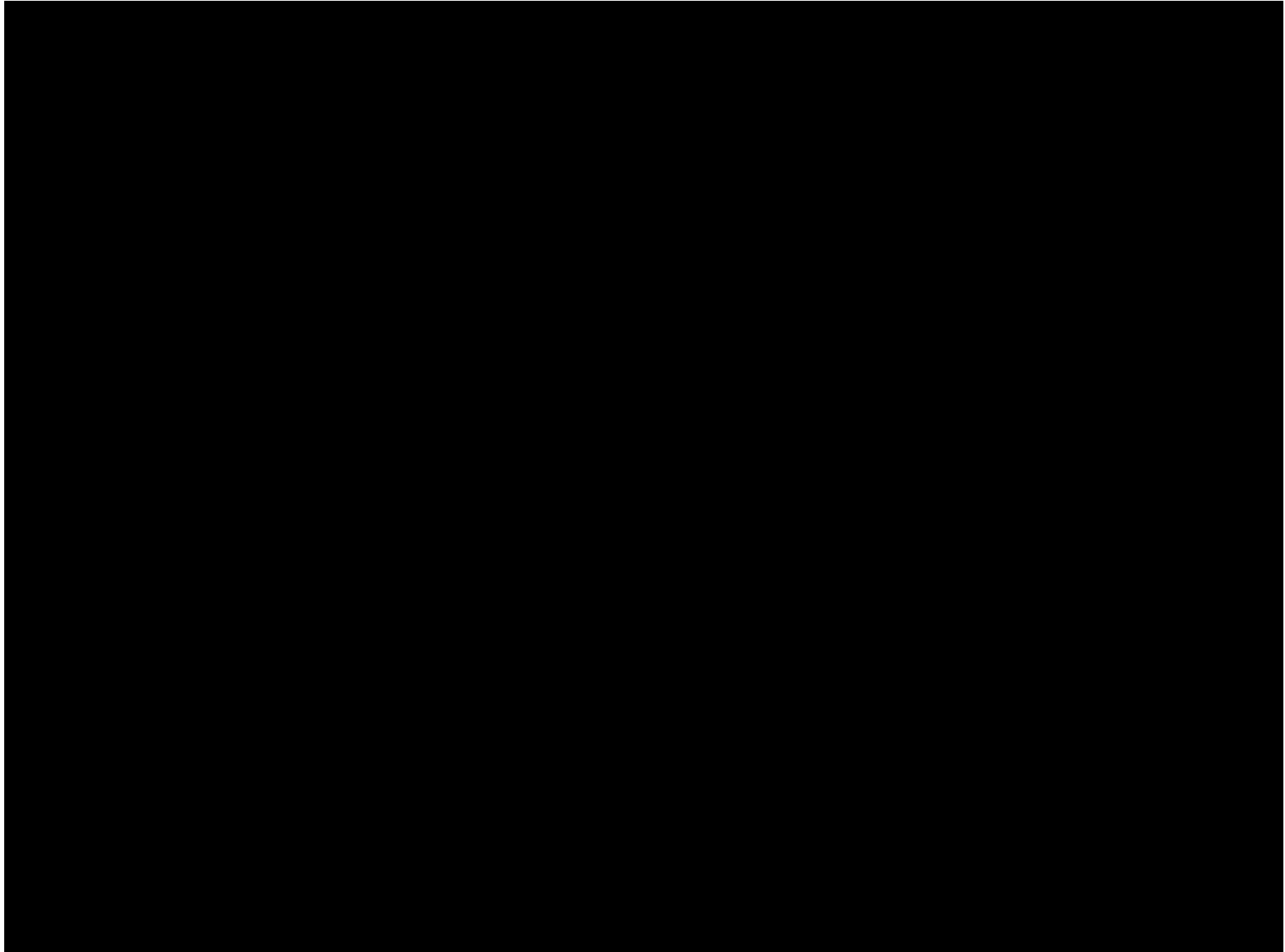

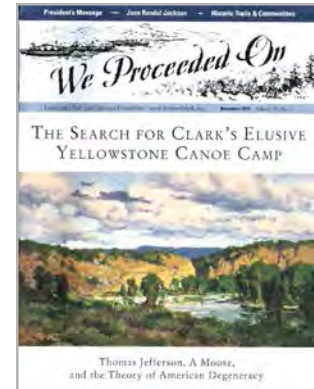
Ralph's Search for Clark's 1806 Canoe Camp



The black bluffs, an historical landmark of interest since 1893, helped to locate the camp site



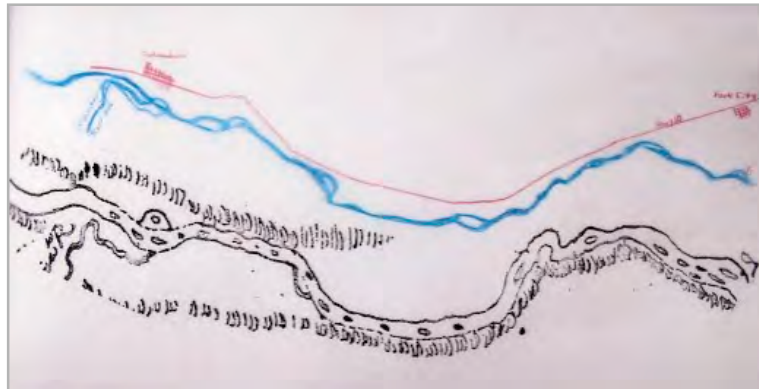
