Biographical/Historical Note:

Sammye Meadows worked as the Tribal Involvement Coordinator of the National Council of the Lewis and Clark Bicentennial's Circle of Tribal Advisor (COTA) from 2005 through 2006. She worked with COTA members to disseminate Lewis and Clark Bicentennial related resource information to tribal governments. She served as the liaison between the National Council of the Lewis and Clark Bicentennial Committee, National Heritage Signature Event Coordinators, Lewis and Clark Bicentennial Commissions, committees and related planners, and tribes for the purpose of promoting and facilitating significant, culturally appropriate and historically accurate tribal involvement in Lewis and Clark bicentennial activities. As Tribal Involvement Coordinator, Sammye worked with governmental, tribal and nonprofit partners to ensure multiple perspectives and Tribal Voices were presented in signature events, conferences, programs, and other activities.

Scope and Contents:

This collection consists of financial records and papers detailing COTA's involvement in signature events, with the Bicentennial Council, with trail stewardship, and involvement with the states.
