Biographical/Historical Note:

Raymond Darwin Burroughs was the editor. This unpublished manuscript was given to the Lewis and Clark Heritage Trail Foundation, Inc. Born in Iowa on August 20, 1899, Raymond Burroughs attended Nebraska Wesleyan University graduating with A.B. degree in 1924 and received M.A. degree from Princeton in 1925. He was an assistant and associate professor at Universities in Salem Oregon, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, and St. Paul, Minnesota. He was on the staff of the Michigan Department of Conservation from 1937 to 1949. He is best known to students and enthusiasts of the Lewis and Clark Expedition as the author of the first book to deal exclusively with the natural history of the exploring enterprise; *The Natural History of the Lewis and Clark Expedition* published in 1961. In 1966, he published *The Lewis and Clark Botanical Discoveries*. His latest publication was titled *Lewis and Clark in Buffalo Country*.
