**Biographical/Historical Note:**

James Fazio, a professor in the College of Natural Resources at the University of Idaho in Moscow, ID, was President of the Lewis and Clark Trail Heritage Foundation from 1992-1993. He served on the Idaho Governor's Lewis and Clark Trail Committee as chair, and as a member of the Idaho Chapter, of which he became president in 1986. During his tenure as president, James Fazio was responsible for helping organize the 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Meeting of the Lewis and Clark Trail Heritage Foundation in Lewiston Idaho with the theme of Lewis and Clark in the Land of the Nez Perce. He published an article entitled *A Bicentennial Wish List: A Look at which dreams for the Lewis and Clark Bicentennial came true* in the August, 2008 *We Proceeded On*. He has written several books including *Across the Snowy Ranges- The Lewis and Clark Expedition in Idaho and Western Montana*.
