**Biographical/Historical Note:** A group of Lewis and Clark Trail Heritage Foundation Members and others interested in establishing a local Chapter in Bigfork met on February 26, 2004. The Chapter's official Charter from the Lewis and Clark Trail Heritage Foundations was signed on August 8, 2004 by President Ron Laycock. Although a non-trail site, the Lewis and Clark enthusiasts' making up this group had a primary objective to provide Lewis and Clark educational experiences for the people and students in the area. Much of the Chapter's programming took place during the Bicentennial Commemoration. The chapter was active in bringing in various speakers, historical reenactors, and organizing a two-day workshop for 4<sup>th</sup> grade students in the area schools. After the Bicentennial years, it was hard to maintain interest or draw Lewis and Clark speakers to the off-trail location causing the Chapter to disband in 2008.

**Scope and Contents:**

The Flathead Chapter of the LCTHF collection includes the chapters operational records and the programming records from the start of the chapter in 2004 to its end in 2008.
